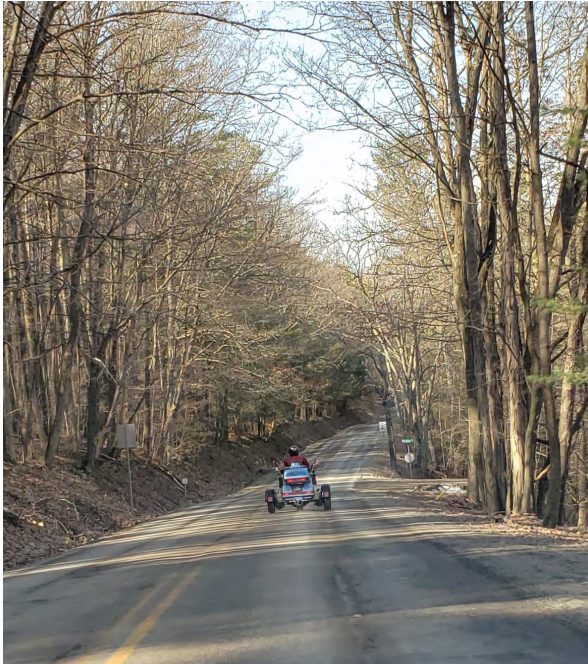

Welcome to MARCH everyone! Finally spring might be arriving so we can get those bikes out. It's been an easy winter, for sure, but



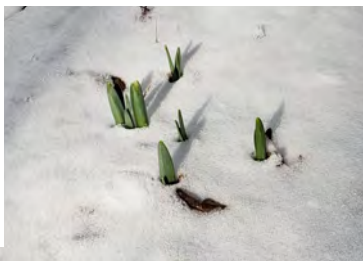
