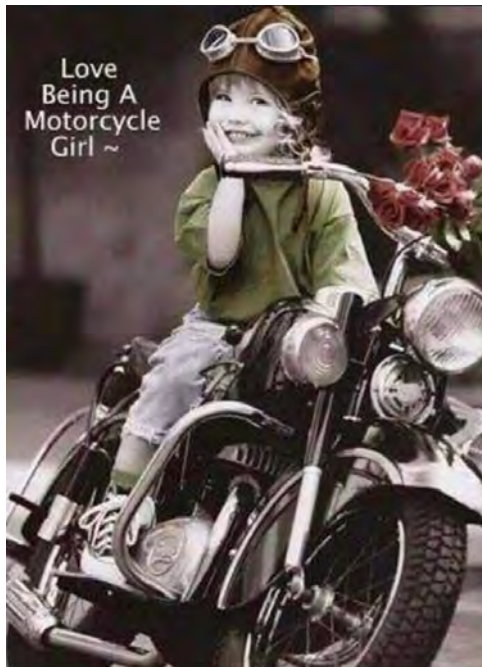

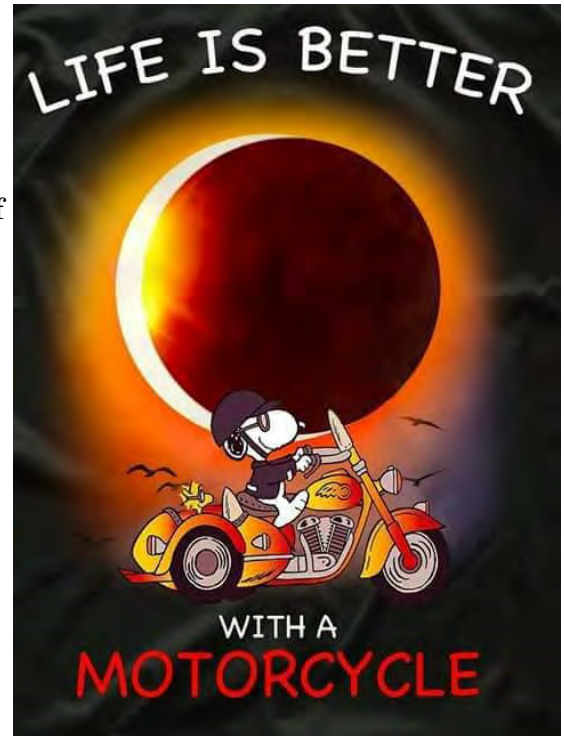
Ed's

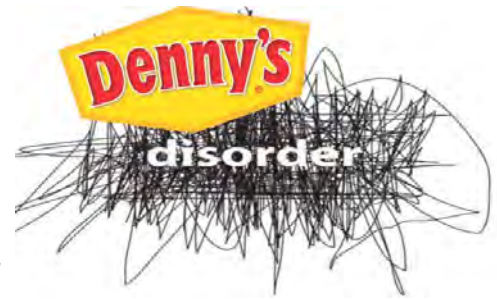
Denny's Disorder

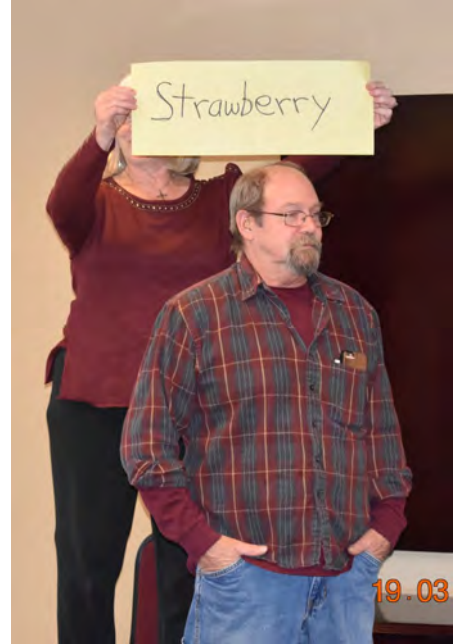


Our annual Ice Cream Party doubled as our March Gathering since the previous weekend was snowy. But we made awesome ice cream sundaes, played games,

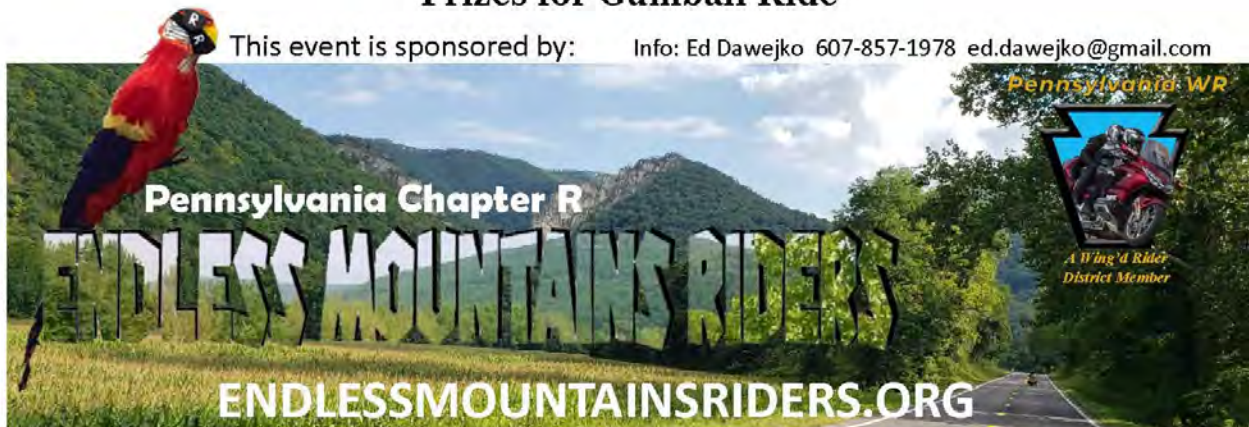

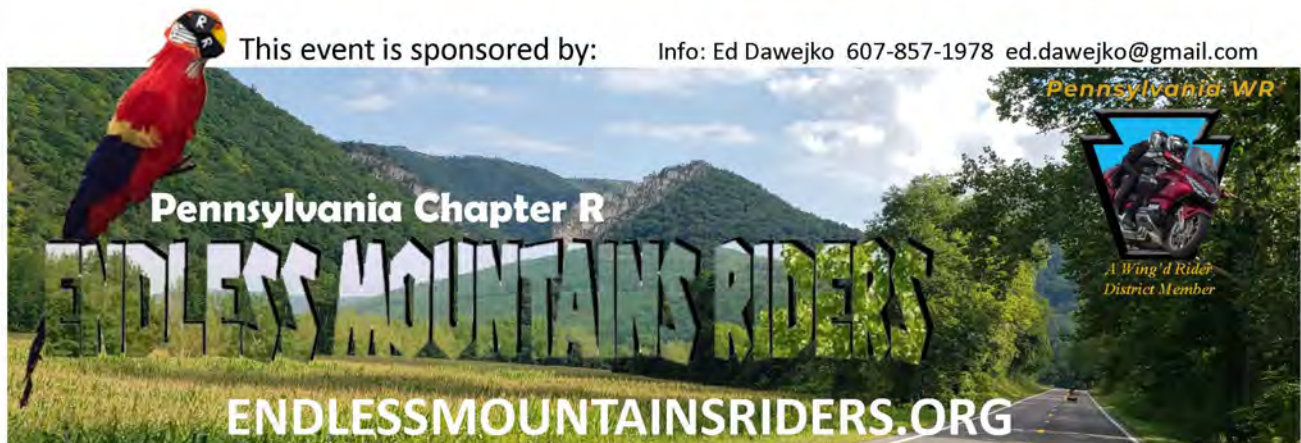
