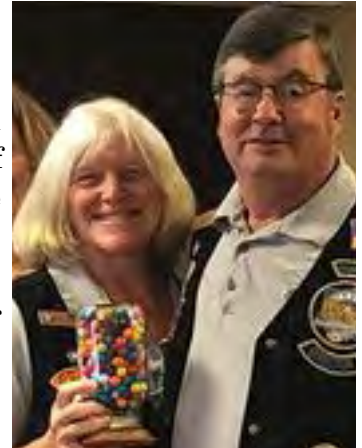

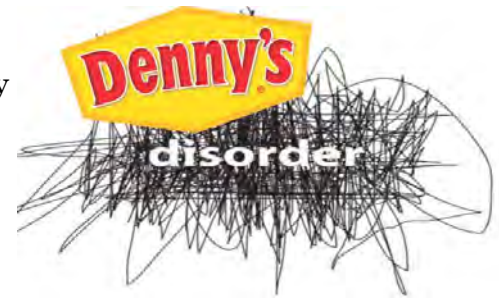

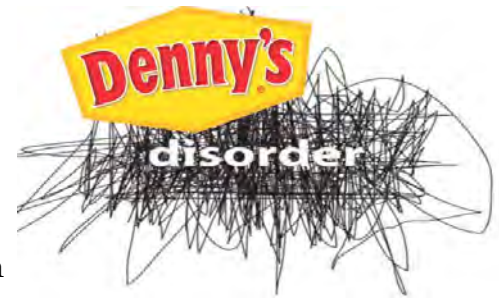
Next up is the Susquehanna Wings PA-H WR Dice Run/Picnic. There is a group of us going

Callear's BBQ

There's nothing like making a huge career switch in 2019 and 8 months later a world-wide pandemic hits. In the restaurant business, that is catastrophic. But the Wohltmans weren't quitters. They are grateful to the community for their support and realize that God has blessed them even through the hard times.

Kyle had been a mailman for 16 years and Raya was a personal trainer, children's church director, and mom to two kids (at that time). They both knew their way around a kitchen and she says, "We like food!" so why not buy a restaurant? The Callears wanted to retire and stayed around to show them the tools of the trade and then sat back to let the young family take over.

"We jumped right in and didn't even have a chance to second guess ourselves," Raya says. "It was so busy and crazy." But the timing could not have been worse. COVID hit just as they were getting their feet wet, and the dining room shut down for 10 weeks. They cut back part time staff and transitioned to take-out. By May of that year they could start doing outside catering.



Today they are adjusting to the new normal. They have switched from daily specials to seasonal specials while keeping the staple menu of chicken, brisket and pulled pork. They have dreams of getting a food truck and Raya sees a little ice cream and coffee shop with a playground out front.

The Wohltmans have three children now - Owen, 9; Avery, 6; and Josephine, 2. Raya had her daughter in the spring of 2021. She was catering a wedding on May 8 and delivered Josie on May 13. The restaurant business does not stop for a baby. Kyle had to leave the hospital to tend to the kitchen, and Raya was doing orders right from her hospital bed!

The kids get involved in the family business in various ways. Owen knows how to bus tables. They do dishes and even some jobs in the kitchen like separating chicken wings. Raya says they were in the van one day when the phone rang, and she heard a child answer it, "Hello, Welcome to Callears." Raya says Josie and her little pigtails help get a lot of traffic on their Facebook page.

Raya enjoys working with her husband. She says in his old job there was a common sense way to do things and then a "postal" sense. Here, he finds a responsibility that he can make sense of. She says they both work well together if they "stay in their own lane." He has the kitchen and she has the catering. But she laughs that Kyle is not the man she married. He grew up outside of Philadelphia and drove an immaculate hatchback. Today he drives a pickup truck, wears flannel and grows a beard every winter.

She says the entire effort would have been impossible without family support. And they are grateful how the community has supported them and how the business is growing.

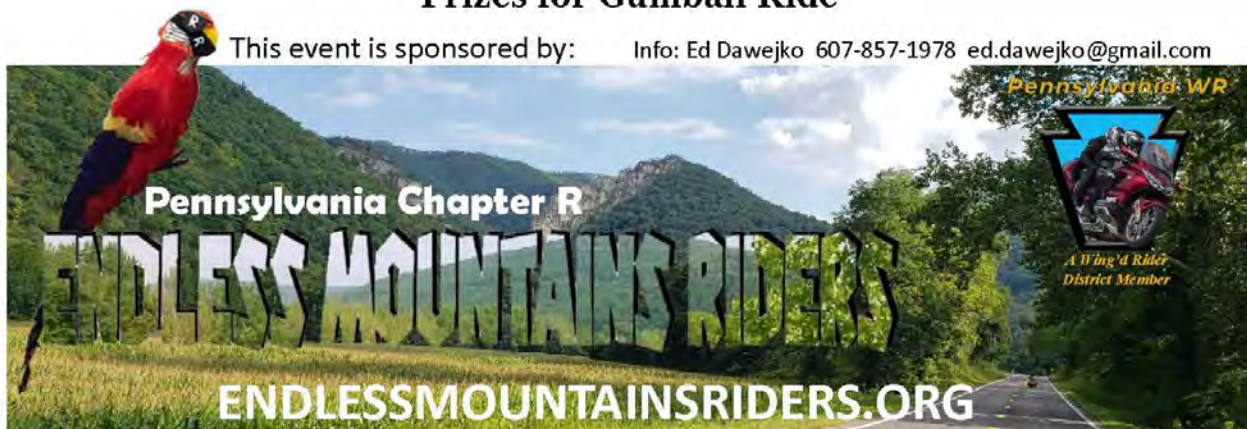

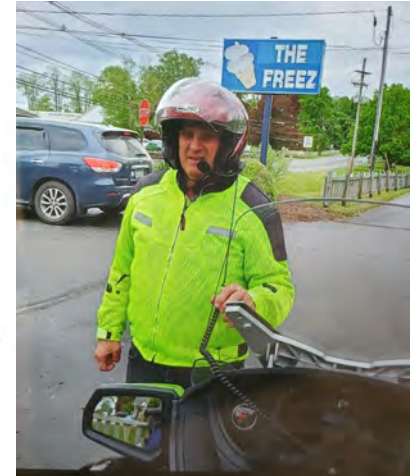
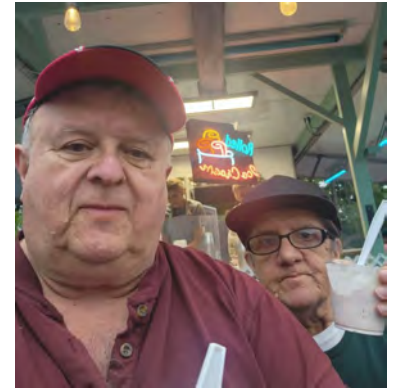
