

Between the Gumball Rally in July and the District Rally in August, we were able to give our local shelters almost \$1,000 worth of supplies and money.



In Memory of the 9-11 Rides



The attack was September 11, 2001 – and a group of us from PA-R visited the crash site in 2007. There was only a temporary memorial – a small building for a Park Ranger to use, a wire fence, some railing to mark off parking space and a most devasting

look at a flag in the field marking where the plane had hit...

There were many, many tribute items, some large and some small that folks had left at the site. The were several large plaques from various motorcycle groups and other organizations. After this trip it was decided that PA-R wanted to do something 'concrete' as our contribution to the memorials there and to honor those that had died.

In 2008, PA-R made a second trip to Shanksville to bring and leave a concrete engraved tribute from our group that we had had created by a company that does stone work.. Also there was a place on the wire fence where folks were leaving patches and emblems, so we also left our chapter patch with the others on the fence. There was even more items that folks had left in tribute...
