And when his bike was ruined in the accident, it didn't take too long and he had a beautiful new machine to ride. He definitely loves to be on the road with it. And we love having him as


a member of this chapter. So we would like to announce that Dale is our 2024 SPECIAL PERSON OF THE YEAR!

bike out anywhere you can get a hamburger and prove that you ate there, and voila - you could be our challenge winner for 2025! We are planning a








