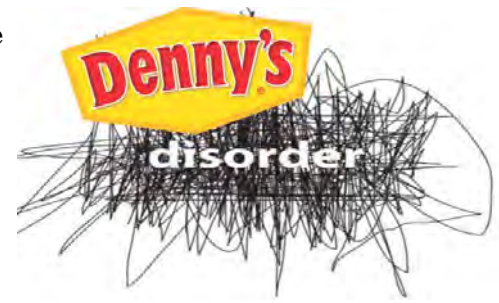

Denny's Disorder



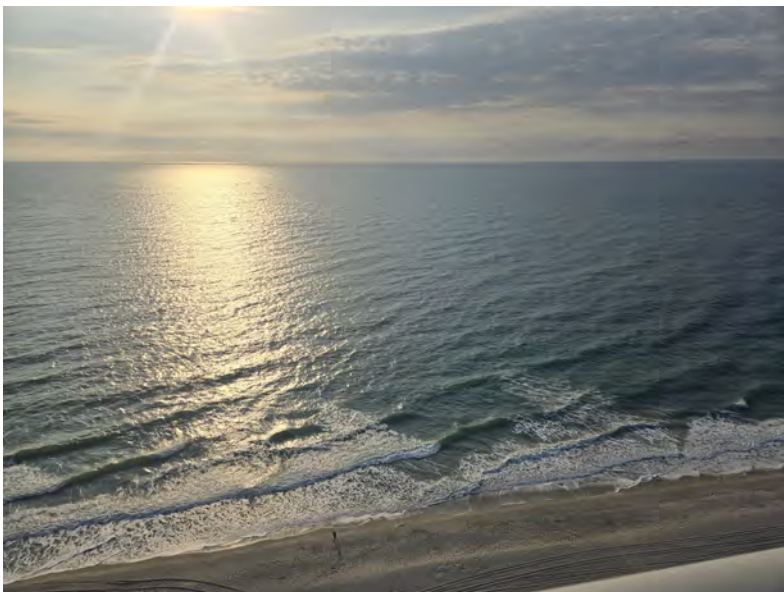

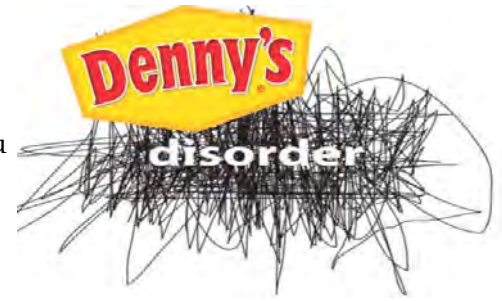

We are looking forward to a lot more fun and events in 2026! Stay tuned for the calendar lineup soon!



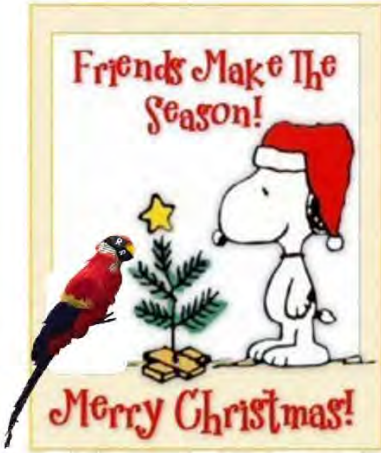
After-Gathering visit to Historical Society
