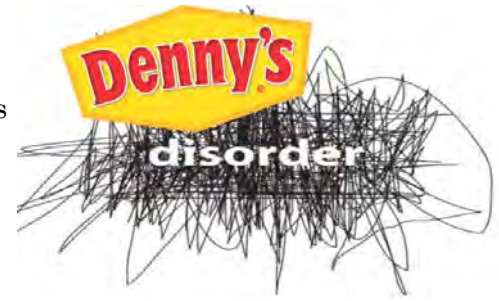

People who say the day they got married is the best day of their life clearly have never bought a motorcycle.



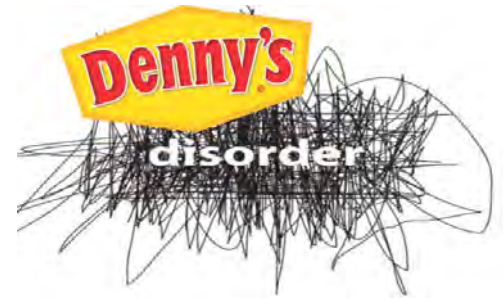
