firmly in place. Maybe we should just scrap the pool and put the money into the motorcycle - what do you think?

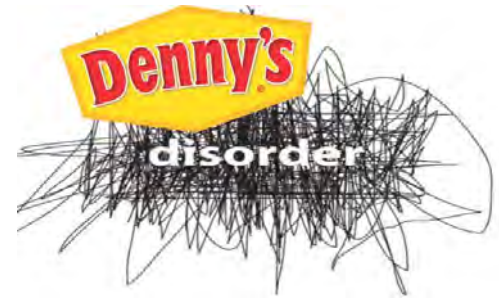

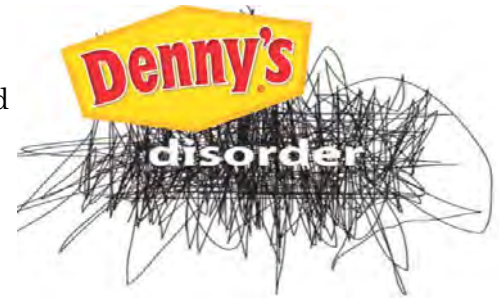
**I'm confused, how can a funeral home raise its prices and blame it on the cost of living!**

It is constructed of all aluminum, tandem axle, finished on the inside, four snowmobiles and is about 30' long. Trailers that big need brakes, which this trailer has, four of them. Also, trailers this size require an annual

inspection, just like your car or truck. So, this fall, I hooked up to my trailer and proceeded to put four black skid marks on my pole barn floor as none of the wheels turned a micro inch. Questioning, I was told my battery in the trailer was no good. I doubted that as I had it on a tender all summer. I changed it anyway. Did not make a difference, just added to the black skid marks. Soooo, I had to have a technician come out and solve the problem. Ended up being all four brakes pads

were stuck to the drums. Some call this "Lot Rot", which is why you see cars & trucks shifted around at dealerships. The tech pounded and worked for quite a while to get all the brakes unstuck. He pounded so hard on one brake drum he actually cracked it. I had to get a new one. Now, I could drive it over to get the inspection done and the new brake drum installed. As habit, I always go around and feel tires and bearings to make sure everything is alright. The new drum installed is so hot, I almost burn my fingers. After consultation with the shop, we turned around and headed there. Even busy, they took me right in and found the new bearing

When we got back, I went to the shop to fill them in and felt there was not much more they could do and were not worried about it being a little warmer than the other three. After a couple thousand dollars, my trailer was back to usable again. So be forewarned, if you have a trailer with brakes, do not let it set for any length of time. Myself? I plan on putting the trailer on jack stands and rotate the tires every time I go to the pole barn.

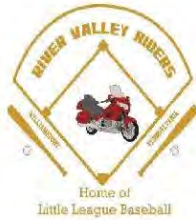
