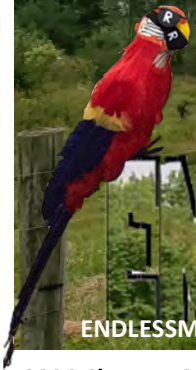

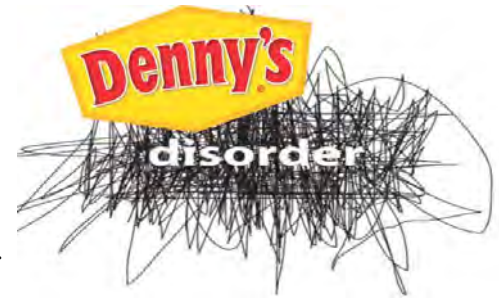

I just realized today that the paper towels by the gas pump are for wiping away tears after you fill up your tank.

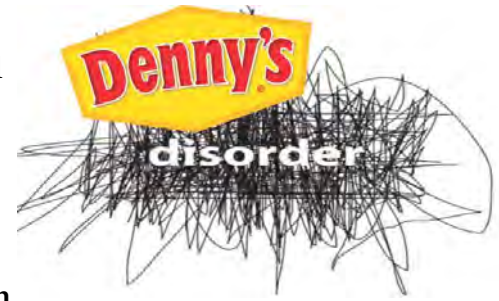
I'm getting amped up for the upcoming weekend. We have our

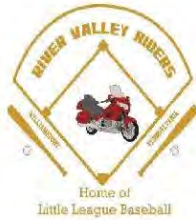
