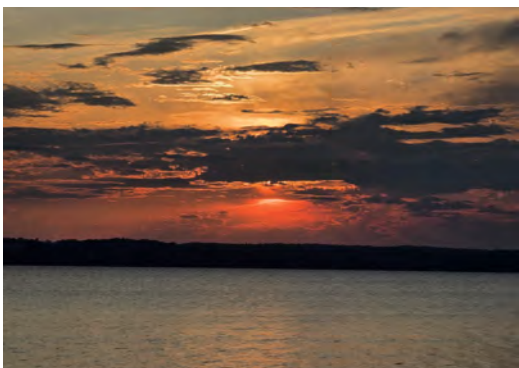

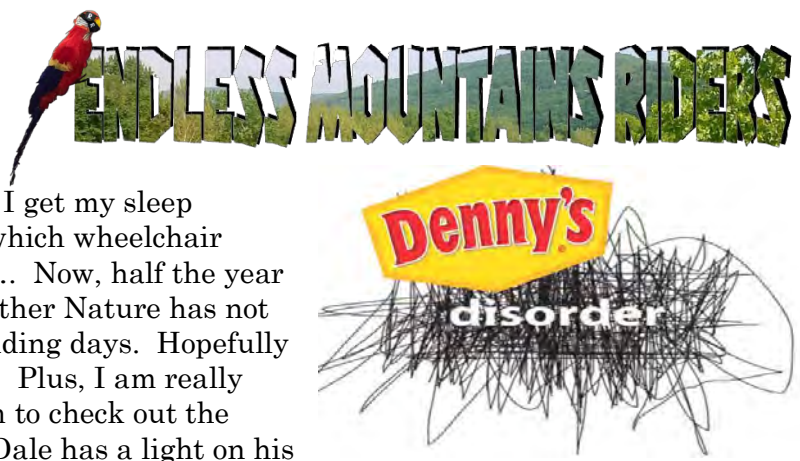

A cop pulled me over and said, "Sir, we are looking for a suspect that fits your description. Where were you between 5 & 6?" I replied, "kindergarten".

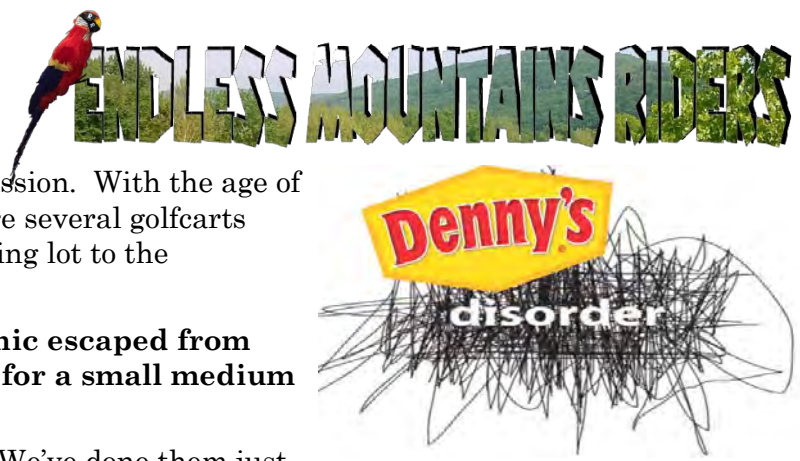

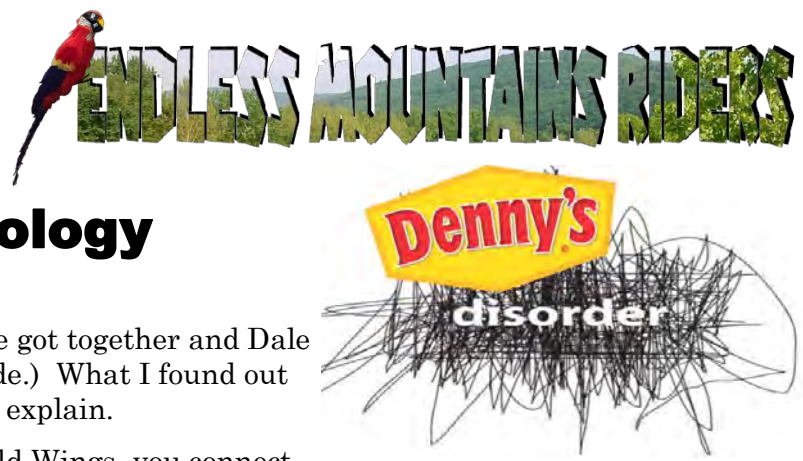

New Mesh Technology

Found out some interesting information when we got together and Dale led us on the Gumball Ride. (It's a really nice ride.) What I found out is this Mesh technology works very well. Let me explain.

Starting in 2018, with the all newly designed Gold Wings, you connect to the bike with Bluetooth technology. This means no cables. I'm not really sure I totally like it, but there is no other choice, so it's wonderful. When connected, or "paired" as the correct terminology, Barb & I can hear our satellite radio, GPS and CB.

Now, these devices, ours is from Sena, can connect with each other thru this 'Mesh' technology, if you know what your doing. Dale has a Sena on his helmet and he has been trying to connect with me for some time, but I haven't been able to figure it out till we went on the Gumball Ride. What makes this technology so interesting is I was able to talk with Dale during the ride while Dale does not have a CB. Same with Donny Chamberlain, who was on the ride.

My CB started working great, so I was able to communicate with Ed & Carla and Bill & Janice thru the CB. This allowed me to communicate with everyone, either by CB or Mesh. Conclusion here? If you have a bike/trike, and don't want to put in a CB, buy one of these Senas (or Cardos is another brand) and you can join in on the conversations while we are riding.

On Amazon, you can get a Sena 50s for \$303.20, cheapest I've found. With the trouble with my CB, I purchased new sets and got the Sena 60s, hoping to solve my CB problem. It did not. Both Dale and Donny have the 50s' and we all connected no problem. If you want

the new and improved Sena 60s, that will run you \$394 on Amazon, again, cheapest I've found. Two of you on the bike, double it as you'll have to buy two of them, \$462.36 for the 50s and \$614.31 for the 60s.

As luck would have it, I happen to have a couple of Sena 50s' in good working order I'm going to be getting rid of for a lot less than what Amazon is charging. Get a hold of me and we will work it out. Bottom line, it is a much less costly alternative to installing a CB on your ride and still allowing you to communicate with the Group.

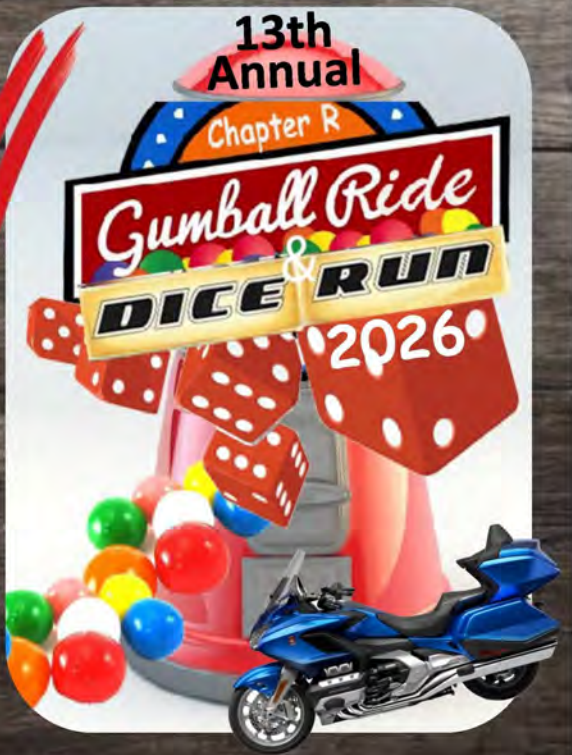

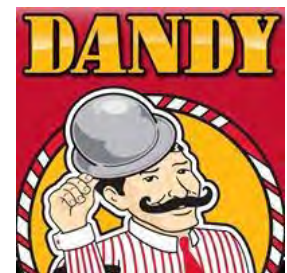

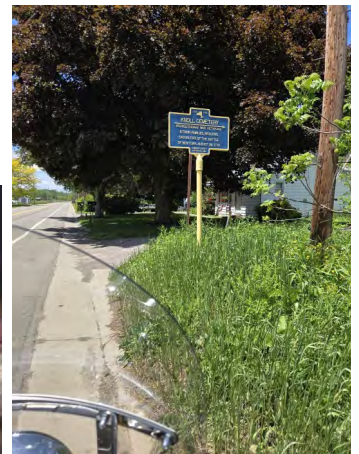
